North Channel Bridge is an NYC beach rich in wildlife. It is used by humans and a variety of bird species like the American oystercatcher and is also a stone's throw from Harbor Heron Island and Jamaica Bay Wildlife Refuge.

The North Channel Bridge Beach Clean-Up is a local offshoot of the global volunteer movement to clean up beaches for marine life, shorebirds and you the beachgoer. This annual international effort is coordinated in NYS by the American Littoral Society. Anyone can participate, and it's a great way both to give back and spend time outdoors.
